Certifies terminal diagnosis

Coordinates care with interdisciplinary team

Home Health Aide

Provides direct personal care to patient

Provides comfort care and reports needs to nurse case manager

Provides emotional support to patient and family

HOSPICE PATIENT and FAMILY

VOLUNTEERS

Provides companionship and support to patient and family

Provides non-medical services and respite to family

Provides support at time of death and during bereavement

BEREAVEMENT COORDINATOR

Provides bereavement support

Provides counseling

Educates community

Memorial Service for patient and family

CHAPLAIN

Assess patient and family spiritual needs

Facilitates life review

Provides counseling to patient and family

Provides bereavement support

SOCIAL WORKER

Assess patient/family social, emotional and financial needs

Assists with end-of-life planning

Provides counseling and education to patient and family
